

Invitation to participate in a tender, with a prequalification and an additional competitive process, for the performance of replacing a section of 32" oil products pipeline in Berth 1 of EAPC Terminal in Ashkelon

- Europe Asia Pipeline Company Ltd. (hereinafter, the "Company") intends to replace a section of the 32" oil products pipeline in Berth 1 of the Ashkelon Terminal, as all detailed at EAPC Site-<u>https://www.eapc.co.il/tenders-page</u>
- 2. A bid that does not meet all of the conditions set forth below may be disqualified:
 - 2.1. If the bidder is a corporation that has been duly incorporated and registered in Israel, by the deadline for submitting the documents at the Pre-Qualification Stage, it must meet the following threshold conditions:
 - 2.1.1. The bidder is a registered contractor under the Registration of Contractors for Construction Engineering Work Law, 5729 -1969, in the branch of ports, maritime works (400) having a classification of 2 'a at least on the deadline for submission of documents in the Pre-Qualification Stage.
 - 2.1.2. The bidder has proven experience (as a prime contractor or as a subcontractor) in planning and performance of works on marine fuel piping Off Shore (including fuel pipe welding work) made of steel and with a diameter of at least 24" at a depth of at least 15 m, which will include welding of joints such as WELD + END in HABITAT a dry underwater, in Israel or abroad.
 - 2.1.3. The bidder is eligible to participate in the Tender and enter into the Contract in accordance with the relevant provisions of Israeli law concerning transactions with public bodies; and the bidder has a valid approval pursuant to the provisions of the Public Entities Transactions Law, 5736-1976
 - 2.1.4. The bidder will declare that no proceedings are being conducted against it for insolvency, liquidation, stay of proceedings, and there is no registration of it being a company in violation of the law or under warning prior to



such registration, on the deadline for the submission of the documents in the Pre-Qualification Stage.

2.2. If the bidder is a foreign contractor, it must meet the following threshold conditions:

- 2.2.1. The bidder has proven experience (as a prime contractor or as a subcontractor) in planning and performance of works on marine fuel piping Off Shore (including fuel pipe welding work) made of steel and with a diameter of at least 24" at a depth of at least 15 m, which will include welding of joints such as WELD + END in HABITAT a dry underwater, in Israel or abroad.
- 2.2.2. The bidder is not subject to sanctions, investigations, or other restrictions by a governmental authority of its home jurisdiction which would render it ineligible to participate in tenders of governmental corporations or other public bodies in its home jurisdiction.
- 2.3. The bidder passed all the EAPC Chief Security Officer Examination.
