2.	In order to quote the proper solution we need the know the temperature values of the media, the working pressure, viscosity etc. This info is not on the specs you have published. Please provide us with the process info ASAP	The information is in the specifications. See paragraphs 2.1 & 3.4.
3.	Please provide us the construction materials per valve. The technical spec does not contain such.	The valve trim should be acceptable for crude oil service.



4. According to article 14 of the Public Tender # 22012689 (The "tender"), we hereby submit the following appeal

Only goods manufactured by one (or more) of the manufacturers mentioned in the Tender are allowed.

We ask EAPC to allow offering Gate valves, according to the specifications of the tender, that are manufactured by, a Valve manufacturer with API certifications, worldwide, and Israeli vast sales reference.

In addition and for avoidance of any doubt, any joint bid or bid which will be submitted by two/more bidders in common are not allowed and will be disqualified.

..... is an approved manufacturer and has references with world-leading customers such as is a mark of a high-quality product.

It must be clarified that in order to approve any other manufacturer, EAPC Engineering Department must examine thoroughly the manufacturer and its manufacturing process according to its professional discretion. Since such examination can take considerable time, it cannot be possible in this Tender.

We declare that Gate Valves DD&B manufactured bya.s are <u>not less than equal in quality and performance</u> to the valves by the factories cited in article 2 of the tender.
